

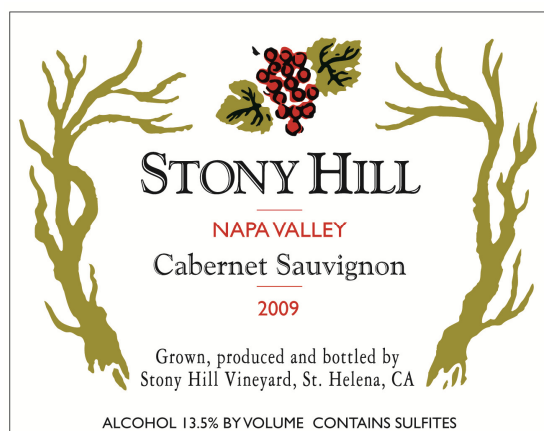

Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon



Known primarily for its white varietals, Stony Hill Vineyard also produces a small amount of Cabernet Sauvignon from its highest vineyard on Spring Mountain. The deep red soil, southwestern exposure and plentiful afternoon sun create a classic environment for the Cabernet grape, producing a wine light in style with mild tannins and a modest alcohol level of 13.5%.

Our 2009 vintage revisits the lovely Cabernets made in Napa in the 1960s and 1970s, restrained in style, immanently drinkable now but with a long future before it. This is an aromatic wine with hints of dark cherry fruit and green olive on the nose. In the mouth we detect a delicate yet powerful fruit presence along with a smoky quality and notable minerality from Stony Hill's rocky soils. The tannins are soft and the finish lingers on and on.
