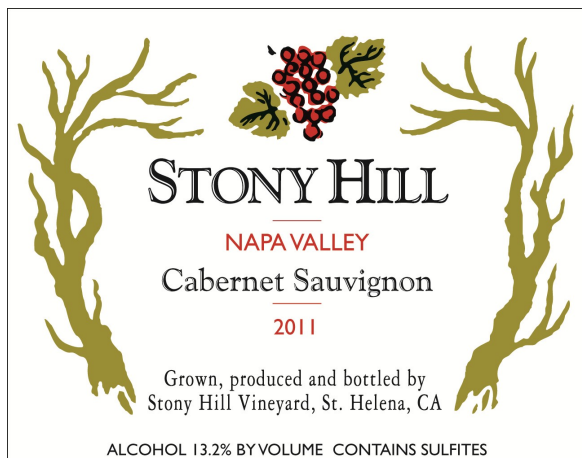

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"I can't believe how much I like this wine," was winemaker Mike Chelini's high praise as he tasted the new release. We noted a whiff of chocolate and dark cherry on the nose and flavors of dark cherries framed by light mountain tannins on the mouth. To us, it's the epitome of old school Cabernet Sauvignon. And with an alcohol level of 13.2%, it fits right in with our winemaking philosophy. Indeed, we've never believed that high alcohol levels and big tannins were necessary to make an enjoyable wine. So when you taste our 2011 Cab we know you'll agree that it's a beautifully balanced wine, pleasingly approachable now with a velvety finish and years in front to mature.
