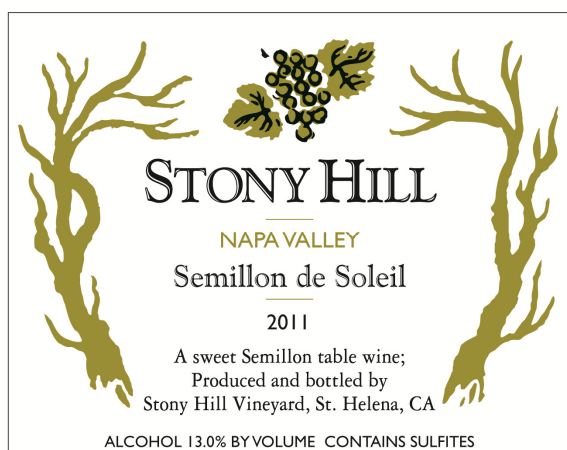

Here is a touch of gold for your glass! One whiff of the 2011 Semillon and you're hooked! It has a very complex aroma of creamy caramel, dried apricots and figs, and a slight touch of honeyed botrytis. The wine is less sweet than usual with 4.5 percent residual sugar, but the explosion of dried fruit flavors in your mouth will enhance any stone fruit dessert or cheese course to finish your meal. The long finish shows the delicious touch of honeyed botrytis which will develop more prominently in years to come.
