Napa Valley Gewurztraminer
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We felt very lucky last fall to have crushed 7.22 tons of Gewurztraminer grapes out of a total of 31.6 tons crushed in all of Napa! That's almost a quarter of the county's whole production. This cooler climate grape has found a sweet spot at Stony Hill with our rocky soils, northeast exposure, and higher elevation where there's always a slight breeze to cool that hot summer sun. Our 2013 vintage is palest straw in color with lovely floral aromas and a lively mouth feel from the wine's crisp acidity. The flavors remind us of exotic Asian pears followed by a spicy and lingering finish. We think it's a great choice to serve with the turkey dinners coming up. With just 11.9% alcohol and its bone-dry, palate-cleansing qualities, it will cut right through all that rich gravy and sausage stuffing. What more could you ask for when looking for the perfect holiday wine!
